Why must we strive in order to enter God's Rest? (4:11)

It's not because we are saved by making ourselves good enough to enter God's Rest. We are only saved by trusting Jesus as Savior, Lord, and Treasure. But when God saves us He promises to keep us striving against so we do not fall from God. So we must strive against sin so we do not fall from God (v.11) — and if we don't strive, and do fall, that would show we had not been saved.

How can we avoid being deceived by sin? (4:12-13)


The author of Hebrews has shown the danger of our sin deceiving us (3:13). But God has given us His Word which will discern the true state of our hearts. This is crucial because we will all give an account to God (4:13).

What should we do when we see sin rising in our hearts? (4:14-16)

First, hold fast our confession that Jesus is our forgiving and sympathetic high priest.

And second, with confidence draw near to the throne of grace — and we will always receive help to resist sin.

So be encouraged. The Word of God will expose every deception. And the Throne of Grace will enable you to resist sin. And you will surely enter God's Rest.



HOME GROUP DISCUSSION OF SUNDAY'S TEACHING

In the past have you fought sin by drawing near to the throne of grace — or by various mental techniques? Why do we tend to use mental techniques instead of coming to the throne of grace?

Why should we come to the throne of grace instead of just using mental techniques?

Have you ever felt discouraged by the difficulty of fighting sin? What difference does it make to see that you have the Word of God which will free you from all deception — and the Throne of Grace which will help you overcome sin?

What questions did Sunday's message raise in your mind?
