THE STORY OF GOD: GOD CREATES A NATION

EXODUS 15-18 — JAN 3, 2010

How did God create the nation of Israel?

God called and changed Abraham (Gen 12:1-3)

God created offspring for Abraham.

God delivered Israel from Egypt.

God chose Israel to be His people (Deu 7:6); not because they were righteous (Deu 9:6) or because they were numerous (Deu 7:7), but because of His merciful love (Deu 7:8).

Why did God focus on a nation?

He placed Israel in the center of the nations (Eze 5:5)

He wanted Israel to show God's nearness and righteousness (Deu 4:7-8)

He did all this to display His glory through Israel (2Sa 7:23)

What do we learn about God as He leads Israel to Sinai?

God provides for His people (Exo 15:22 - 17:7).


God responds to His people when they pray (Exo 17:8-16).

God welcomes Gentiles who trust Him (Exo 18:1-12)

What's the take-away?

Feast on God as He reveals Himself in the Old Testament.

Trust God to provide for you, respond when you pray, welcome you as you trust Jesus.
