
The Letter To The Hebrews Christ Our High Priest Hebrews 5:1-10



Why do we need a High Priest? (5:1-4)

Because sinful people need someone to represent them before God with a sacrifice for their sins (v.1).

Because sinful people need a representative who sympathizes with their weakness (v.2)

Because sinful people need a representative who is perfect and sinless (v.3)

Because sinful people need a High Priest who is appointed by God (v.4).

How is Jesus Christ this perfect High Priest? (5:5-10)

Because He was appointed by God Himself (v.5)

Because as the Son of God Jesus is fully God (v.5)


Because God appointed Jesus to be a priest forever, as pictured in Melchizedek (v.6)

Because Jesus sympathizes with our weaknesses, since He battled in prayer for God's help against sin (v.7)

Because Jesus' sinlessness means He can represent us before God (vv.8-10)

What does this mean for us?

Whenever you have a need, see that Jesus can be your High Priest, connect to Him by faith, and through Him draw near to God.
