What kingdom was here before Jesus came?

John 14:29-20

Satan's kingdom was here with three horrifying results:

1. Sin's power and wickedness increased
2. Demonic beings tormented people
3. Sickness spread throughout the earth

How can we be freed from Satan's kingdom?

By Jesus' death on the Cross, removing the guilt that brought us Satan's kingdom.

What happened when Jesus brought God's kingdom?

Jesus freed people from sin's power (Luke 19:8)

Jesus freed people from demons (Mat 9:32-33)

Jesus healed the sick (Matt 4:32-33)

Why is Satan's kingdom still around?

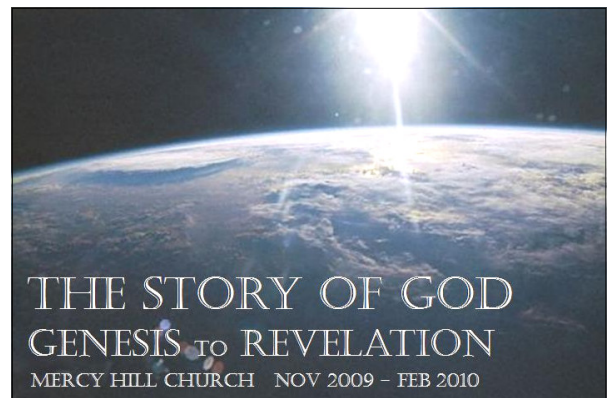
Luke 13:18-21

Because God's kingdom grows slowly, taking back ground from Satan's kingdom, until the Second Coming.

What does Jesus call us to do in the meantime?

Matt 12:28-29
