The wonder of God's salvation (57:14-21)

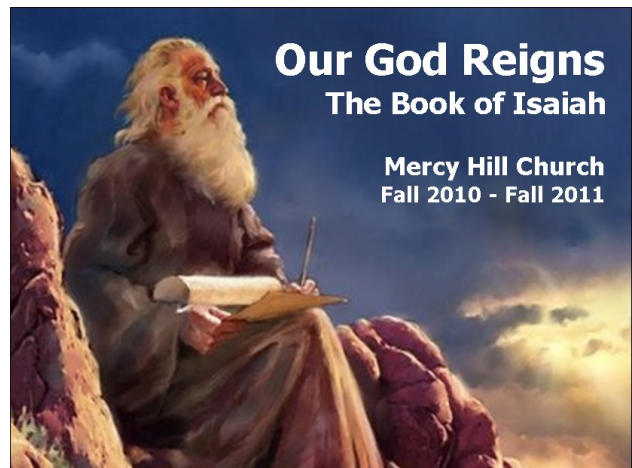
God is merciful (vv.14-15)
