<u>The Letter To The Hebrews</u> Why Cling To The Word About Jesus Hebrews 1:5-14

Ar we supposed to cling to Jesus - or to words about Jesus?

The answer is — BOTH.

Christianity IS about having a relationship with Jesus.

But Jesus is most powerfully known THROUGH the Word of God.

That's why the author wants his readers to cling to the Bible's words about Jesus.

But the problem is that many of his readers have bought false teaching about angels — that angels are superior to Jesus. This is keeping them from clinging to the Word about Jesus.

So in vv.5-14 he corrects their view of angels — and gives us four reasons to cling to the Word about Jesus —

Why should we cling to the Bible's Words about Jesus?

Because Jesus is the only Son of God and He is worshiped by angels (vv.5-6)


Because when we cling to Jesus we are clinging to God Himself (vv.7-9)

Because Jesus, who created everything, will never change (vv.10-12)

Because Jesus is king over everything and because God will use angels to help us (vv.13-14)

What does this mean for us?

Cling to the Bible's words about Jesus.
