Why Seek Satisfaction in God? Isaiah 55:3-13

Introduction

In Isaiah 55:1-3a God calls us to stop pursuing our heart-hungers and thirsts in things that won't satisfy, and instead to start pursuing our heart-hungers and thirsts in Him.

Then in vv.3-13 God gives us four reasons why we should turn from everything else and seek our heart-satisfaction in Him alone.

Because if we seek God, He promises that His work of satisfying us will be everlasting. (3b-5)

God will make an "everlasting covenant" with us — there will never be a time when we can't turn to Him and be fully satisfied.

Israel was concerned that other peoples and nations would get in the way. But God reminds he of what He did for David, and promised that He would work through her to bring other nations to God.

Because if we seek God we will find heart-satisfaction in Him. (6)

If we seek God in Jesus Christ, we will have a first-hand experience of Him that will fully satisfy our heart-hungers and thirsts.

Because if we seek Him God will meet us with compassion and pardon. (7-11)

Because of Jesus' death for our sins, when wicked and unrighteous people seek God He meets them with compassion and pardon (v.7).


Even though this shocks us — this is how God operates (vv.8-9).

Because God has promised this, and God's Word are always fulfilled, we can be absolutely of God's compassion and abundant pardon in Christ (vv.10-11).

Because if we seek him, our eternal satisfaction will be so spectacular that creation will sing and clap. (12-13)

These verses describe both Israel's return from exile, and our future existence in the new heavens and earth.

Our experience of satisfaction in God will be spectacular — it will last forever, be full, and be ever-increasing.
